
Electricity Contract

When trying to get a good electricity agreement you must be aware of the variability in the market. As you can see below the market in the past five years has seen some serious fluctuations, most in the past few years. There has been a general rise in prices early 2017, and when looking at external factors we don't foresee prices reducing, so securing a contract sooner and for a longer term will protect you from further price increases.

Getting the electricity contract you need...

Suppliers act on different time scales when sending out their renewal offers; however, your renewal window can be anything up to 18 months from your contract end date. We advise that you act as soon as you can to get the most beneficial contract possible, in what we believe to be a rising market. Acting as soon as possible...
